



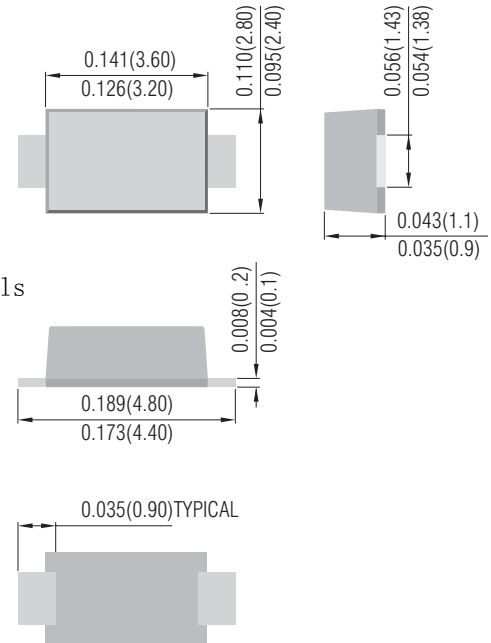

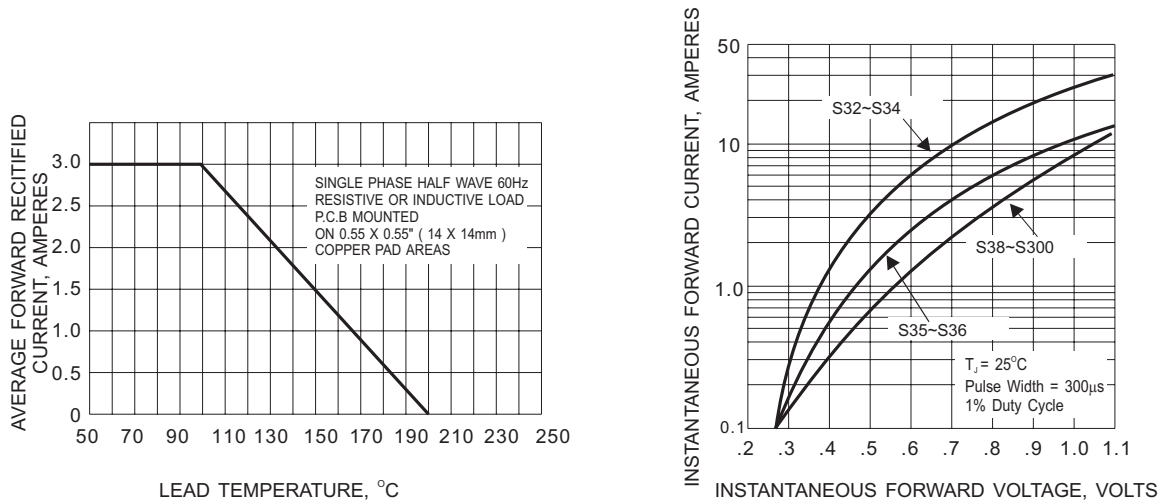


Fig.1- FORWARD CURRENT DERATING CURVE

Fig.2- TYPICAL INSTANTANEOUS FORWARD CHARACTERISTIC

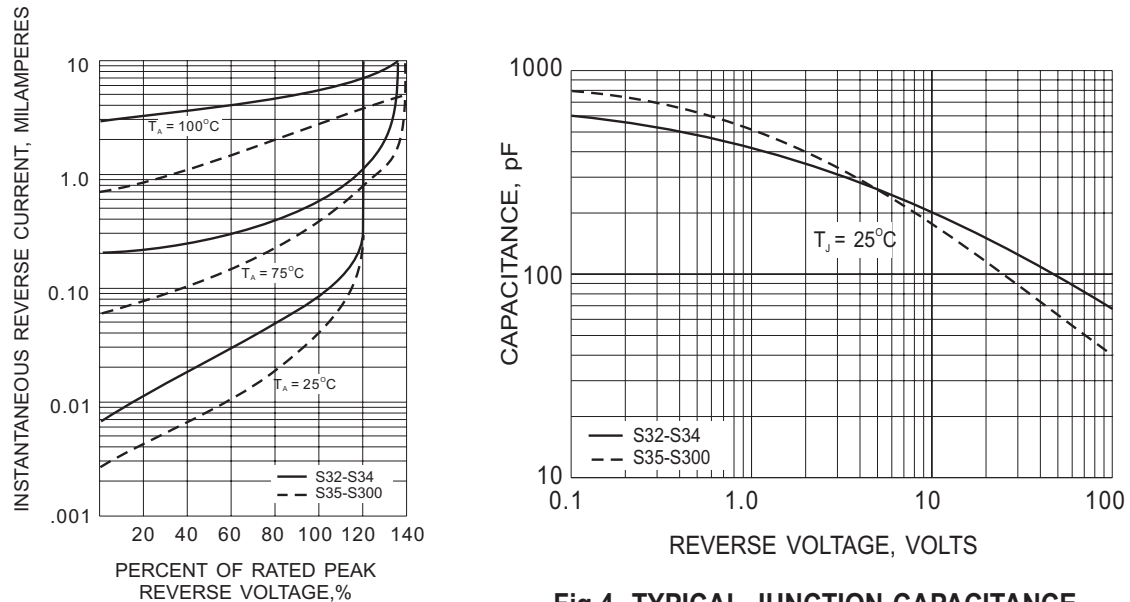


Fig.3- TYPICAL REVERSE CHARACTERISTIC

Fig.4- TYPICAL JUNCTION CAPACITANCE

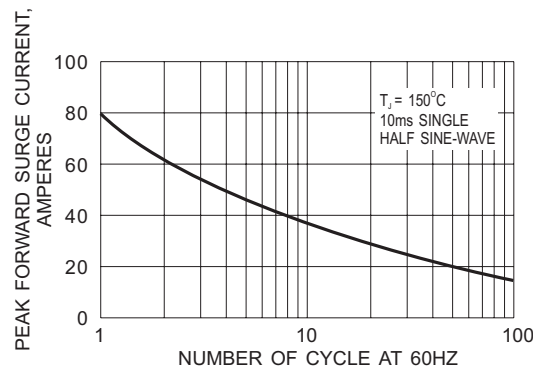


Fig.5- MAXIMUM NON-REPETITIVE PEAK FORWARD SURGE CURRENT
